## PUBLIC NOTICE

The Catahoula Parish Police Jury will have an 8-mill property tax **RENEWAL** Proposition on the April 30, 2022 ballot.

This is a **RENEWAL** of the current millage that is used for multiple expenses for numerous offices which provide public services, including (but not limited to) the following:

Police Jury administration office expenses, courthouse utilities, maintenance and supplies, prisoner care, partial expenses for 7th Judicial District Attorney & Judge's offices, Registrar of Voters & Clerk of Court; mailing of Criminal Jury summons; Coroner Fees (including autopsies and coroner emergency certificates).

This millage is the main source of revenue for funding these expenses.

This is not a new tax – it is only a **RENEWAL**.

### A "YES" VOTE MEANS:

The continuation of the Police Jury to maintain these expenditures which are mandated by law for the jury to fund.

### A "NO" VOTE MEANS:

A decrease in revenue will not allow the jury to fund these expenditures and would cause a hardship to maintain the courthouse and pay mandated expenses of other government offices which provide public services.
