Most forecast models indicate that dry conditions will persist this weekend into early next week as frontal boundaries remain farther north of the region. Some increase in clouds along with light to moderate southerly winds and warmer than average temperatures are expected. 

On April 12, 2022 @ 6:00 P.M. a regular council meeting was held in the meeting room at the Town hall. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Hiram Evans. Roll was called by Anlyne Gardner, Town Clerk. Present were council members: Bruce Lofton, Loria Hollins and Catina Branch. Also present was the Town Attorney, Russell Purvis, Dona Manuel, CPA via phone call during the meeting to present monthly financials and answer questions. Absent council members were Benny Vault Sr. & Josie Bullitts.
 The invocation was given by Council Member Bruce Lofton and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Chief Richard Madison of the Jonesville Police Department.
 Mayor Evans asked for any person(s) to identify themselves to identify the agenda item(s) in which they wish to comment on in accordance with Act 850 of 2010.

There was no response.
 A motion was made by Council Member Bruce Lofton and seconded by Council Member Catina Branch to approve the minutes for the March 8th regular meeting and the special meetings on March 23, & 31, 2022. Motion was carried.
 A motion was made by Council Member Loria Hollins and seconded by Council Member Catina Branch to approve the monthly bills. Motion was carried.
 Recognition of Visitors-Delegators
 Ana Gouge of LSU gave an update on the Story Walk Project- The Town of Jonesville has been approved for the Story Walk and Council will need to confirm the location of placement of the project.
 Aaron Robinson of JCP Management, the Third-Party Management Company gave the monthly report for the water & sewer department. A motion was made by Council Catina Branch and seconded by Council Loria Hollins to except the report. Motion was carried.
 Dona Manuel, CPA, of Knight Masden, Accounting for the Town of Jonesville gave the monthly financial report.
 A motion was made by Council Loria Hollins and seconded by Council Catina Branch to table the request from Mr. Wilbert Miller. Motion was carried.
 A motion was made by Council Member Bruce Lofton and seconded by Council Loria Hollins to use the services of Sondra Redmon as the planning facilitator(unpaid/volunteer) for the Love Louisiana Outdoors Grant Project. Motion was carried.
 A motion was made by Council Member Bruce Lofton and seconded by Council Member Catina Branch to approve JCP Management to purchase the Badger Water Software upgrade for the Jonesville Water Department at quoted figure of \$5,500. Motion was carried.
 A motion was made by Council Member Loria Hollins and seconded by Council Member Bruce Lofton to request RFQ for engineering services for the parks' playground equipment for the Love Louisiana Outdoors Grant Program. Motion was carried.
 A motion was made by Council Member Loria Hollins and seconded by Council Member Catina Branch to apply for the Pipeline & Hazardous Materials Safety Administration Grant in order to improve the towns Natural Gas Program. Motion was carried.
 A motion was made by Council Member Loria Hollins and seconded by Council Member Catina Branch to commit \$10,000. From the general fund to the Love Louisiana Outdoors Park Project. Motion was carried.
 A motion was made by Council Member Loria Hollins and seconded by Council Member Bruce Lofton to adopt a resolution for the Town of Jonesville 2022 Language Access Plan for Limited English Proficiency Persons. Motion was carried.
 Mayor Evans informed the Council that only one firm responded to the RFQ's. Then Mayor Evans recommended that council excepts McManus Engineering for the Glenn Ditch Project.
