Early Notice and Public Review of a Proposed Activity in a 100-Year Floodplain and/or Wetlands

This is to give notice that the Village of Harrisonburg has determined that the following proposed action under the Village's Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG-CV) program is located in the 100-year floodplain, and the Village of Harrisonburg will be identifying and evaluating practicable alternatives to locating the action in the floodplain and the potential impacts on the floodplain from the proposed action, as required by Executive Order 11988 and 11990, in accordance with HUD regulations at 24 CFR 55.20 Subpart C Procedures for Making Determinations on Floodplain Management and Protection of Wetlands.

The proposed project will construct a splash pad within the Steamboat Park located near the intersection of Pine St. and Catahoula St., consisting of a fully functioning splash pad, and ancillary activities including electrical/water service, concrete sidewalk for ADA compliance, ADA features, benches, fences, vegetation, grading, and site preparation.

There are three primary purposes for this notice. First, people who may be affected by activities in floodplains and those who have an interest in the protection of the natural environment should be given an opportunity to express their concerns and provide information about these areas. Second, an adequate public notice program can be an important public educational tool. The dissemination of information about floodplains can facilitate and enhance Federal efforts to reduce the risks associated with the occupancy and modification of these special areas. Third, as a matter of fairness, when the Federal government determines it will participate in actions taking place in floodplains, it must inform those who may be put at greater or continued risk.

Written comments must be received by the Village of Harrisonburg at the following address on or before May 12, 2022: Johnny Cox, Mayor, Village of Harrisonburg, P.O.Box 658, Harrisonburg, Louisiana, 71340. The Village can be contacted by phone at 318-744-5794. A full description of the project may also be reviewed upon request from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the City Hall, Harrisonburg, Louisiana.
