Absent, Council Benny Vault Sr. Russell Purvis, Town Attorney was also present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Bruce Lofton and the Invocation was given by Town Attorney, Russell Purvis.

A motion by Council Bruce Lofton and second by Council Josie Bullitts to adopt a resolution for the Town of Jonesville Taxiway C Safety Improvements Cross Drainage Replacement at the Jonesville Municipal Airport for submitted proposals. Motion was carried

A motion by Council Loria Hollins and second by Council Catina Branch to adopt a resolution on the construction and professional services to complete the Taxiway C Safety Improvements Cross Drain Replacement Project at the Jonesville Municipal Airport with a five-year Capital Improvement Plan.
